- Saturdays from 9:30am – 12:30pm, 39 weeks per year (term-time only)
- 3 hours per week, meets national minimum wage
- Holiday pay is paid every 3 months in addition to your wages

Project Details

On Saturday mornings in term-time we have a range of projects for children aged 6 – 17 with learning disabilities and/or autism.

Our Saturday projects are:

- Communicate (developing communication and social interaction)
- Shine Out on Saturday (drama, music, dance and visual arts)
- Soundbites (recording and editing audio such as podcasts)

Role Description

The Support Worker role works across all of our projects and may be required to support in any of the above groups. The Support Worker takes the lead with running break and snack times for all children and monitoring our room for parents/carers. The Support Worker also assists with project administration, resource management and setting up activities.

Person Specification

- Understand the issues facing children with a learning disability and their families
- Be able to engage positively with children
- Be consistent in setting boundaries with young people
- Be enthusiastic, creative and outgoing

Training in Safeguarding, Food Hygiene and Working with Children with a Learning Disability and/or Autism will be provided.
